Lovely sweet fruit heralds this Pinot, which fills the mouth with cherry, chocolate, licorice and spice flavors before the dense, ripe tannins emerge at the end. There's a nice long finish. Best from 2011 through 2020. 100 cases made.—B.S.

91 Jean-Claude Belland Corton Clos de la Vigne au Saint 2006 \$100

Despite a compact profile and a firm structure, this is very delicate and civilized for Corton. At its center is sweet red cherry, berry, spice and mineral flavors. Shows fine balance and a long finish. Best from 2010 through 2020. 150 cases made.—B.S.
