92 Jean-Marc Bouley Volnay Clos des Chênes 2003 \$55 Plenty of new oak adds sweet spices to the blackberry and plum flavors in this hefty red. It's supple from the start, until the ripe tannins emerge on the finish. Impressive for its combination of weight and balance. Best from 2008 through 2020. 112 cases made.—B.S.

90 Jean-Marc Bouley Volnay 2003 \$36 Concentrated flavors of black cherry, black currant and mineral in this intense red. It's fresh, harmonious and resonates on the long finish. Drink now through 2012. 500 cases made.—B.S.

90 Jean-Marc Bouley Volnay Les Carelles 2003 \$48 Tightly knit and pure, this is elegant for '03, showing cherry, black currant and mineral notes. The finely meshed tannins lend support as well as moderate acidity. Needs time though. Best from 2008 through 2015. 120 cases made.—B.S.
