#### Burgundy / Volnay

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**90 Jean-Marc Bouley Volnay Clos des Chênes 2007 \$90** A cherry-flavored red, tinged with spice, showing weight and polish. The tannins are present, as much from the wood as the grapes, yet there's also sweetness on the finish. Best from 2012 through 2020. 190 cases made.—B.S.

**90 Jean-Marc Bouley Volnay Les Carelles 2007 \$75** Offers a lovely expression of fruit, evoking pomegranate, blueberry and raspberry notes on a delicate frame. There's structure to back it up, and the overall impression is balance and harmony. Best from 2011 through 2018. 100 cases made.—B.S.

**90 Jean-Marc Bouley Volnay Vieilles Vignes 2007 \$54** Ripe and succulent, with a tart, spicy edge, this red teases with its raspberry, red currant and slightly peppery notes. Supple yet firm, this lingers with a crushed fruit aftertaste. Drink now through 2016. 300 cases made.—B.S.

**89 Jean-Marc Bouley Volnay Clos de la Cave 2007 \$54** Rich and full of sweet blackberry fruit, all the while staying fresh and lively. The plump, fruity profile is reined in by the acidity on the lingering finish. Drink now through 2017. 190 cases made.—B.S.
