92 Jean Chauvenet Nuits-St.-Georges 2005 \$48

Terrific expression. Rich, wild berry and black fruit aromas and flavors get texture from the dense tannins. Yet it all remains fresh and delineated, with mineral and earth notes on the long, energetic finish. Best from 2012 through 2022. 100 cases imported.—B.S.

92 Jean Chauvenet Nuits-St.-Georges Rue de Chaux 2005 \$75

Gorgeous black cherry and black currant fruit flavors are shaded by iron and mineral elements. Lively, with firm tannins and intensity that builds through the long, mineral-infused aftertaste. Best from 2012 through 2030. 40 cases imported.—B.S.

90 Jean Chauvenet Nuits-St.-Georges Les Bous-selots 2005 \$80

Deep aromas of red and black currant, with wild berries. On the palate, the oak tannins dominate now. Vibrant and stiff, with a dry finish, but this is long, with a lot going on in the mix. Be patient. Best from 2012 through 2025. 15 cases imported.—B.S.
