Domaine Courbis. Laurent Courbis has produced two sets of sweet, fruit-driven wines marked by lush texture and sexy oak spices. The gentle structure and exuberant fruit of the Courbis wines allow them to be enjoyed in their youth, but they possess the concentration and balance to develop positively in the cellar. I found the fresh 2003 single-vineyard bottlings particularly successful, especially in light of vintage conditions.
