Rhône / Other Red

90 **Domaine Courbis Cornas La Sabarotte**
2004 \$75 Rather roasted for a 2004, with dark olive, hoisin sauce, coffee and tar notes backed by a dark, fleshy finish. Solid power and depth, with nice minerality and acidity. Drink now through 2016. 415 cases made.—J.M.

89 **Domaine Courbis Cornas Champelrose**
2004 \$45 A solid beam of red cherry and plum fruit, with green and black olive notes and a chalky, mineral hint to the finish. Drink now through 2013. 1,665 cases made.—J.M.

Rhône / St.-Joseph

90 **Domaine Courbis St.-Joseph Les Royes**
2004 \$35 Very silky and pure, with a great tangy mineral streak piercing the red plum and black cherry fruit. Long finish. Drink now through 2011. 1,415 cases made.—J.M.

88 **Domaine Courbis St.-Joseph 2004 \$27**
Good straightforward plum, grilled herb and floral notes, with modest intensity on the finish. Drink now through 2009. 4,165 cases made.—J.M.

88 **Domaine Courbis Cornas Les Eygats 2004 \$45** Forward, juicy raspberry and blackberry fruit flavors pick up mineral and olive hints on the finish. Drink now through 2011. 365 cases made.—J.M.
