91 **Domaine Courbis St.-Joseph White 2010**

\$35 Pure and racy, with piercing yellow apple, Cavailon melon and salted butter notes laced with chamomile and quinine. Long, with gorgeous mouthfeel on the finish. Drink now through 2013. 850 cases made.—J.M.
