

# Accolades for Domaine Dupont-Tisserandot's 2003s

#### Côte de Nuits / Gevrey-Chambertin Grand Cru

- **94 Dupont-Tisserandot Mazis-Chambertin 2003 \$125** Ripe, fleshy and generous with black cherry, plum and vanilla aromas and flavors, this almost seems too easy. But there's concentration and intensity and, ultimately, a mineral note and freshness on the finish. A fine mix of power and finesse. Best from 2009 through 2025. 75 cases made.—B.S.
- **93 Dupont-Tisserandot Charmes-Chambertin 2003 \$125** Classy. A cashmerelike texture sets the stage for pure cherry and berry flavors. There's a hint of spice, but the oak is well-absorbed by the lush fruit. This seems very accessible, with a wall of ripe tannins that prolong the finish. Give this time. Best from 2008 through 2020. 120 cases made.—B.S.
- **92 Dupont-Tisserandot Gevrey-Chambertin La Petite Chapelle 2003 \$75** This is vibrant and pure, showing blackberry and cassis aromas and flavors that pick up earth and mineral notes by the finish. Young and well-structured with dense but not overpowering tannins. Excellent balance. Best from 2008 through 2018. 50 cases made.—B.S.
- **89 Dupont-Tisserandot Gevrey-Chambertin 2003 \$45** Very pure and bright, showing black cherry, berry and spice notes. It begins very silky, then the tannins take over. They are fine and ripe, working in tandem with the acidity. Moderate length. Drink now through 2012. 600 cases made.—B.S.
- **89 Dupont-Tisserandot Gevrey-Chambertin Lavaux St.-Jacques 2003 \$75** Very ripe and soft in structure, this reveals ample fruit but comes off a bit flat today. A more elegant version, with firm tannins and a fine length. Drink now through 2012. 180 cases made.—B.S.
