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Accolades for Dupont-Tisserandot

FRANCE

Burgundy / Côte de Nuits Red Grand Cru / Chambertin & Nearby Crus

- 94 Dupont-Tisserandot Mazis-Chambertin 2001 \$80** Fantastic quality, especially in the '01 vintage. Elegant yet bold, thick in texture, blending smoke, tar and toasted oak with great depth of raspberries and black fruit. Full-bodied, supple and sweet tannins, with a long, refined finish. Best from 2006 through 2014.—P.M.
- 91 Champy Mazis-Chambertin 2001 \$105** Harmonious from start to finish. Rich, ripe, thick and bursting with pure and elegant Pinot Noir aromas and flavors, this full-bodied red Burgundy is very special, with blackberries, wild raspberries, smoke, mineral, and a lingering, sweet-tasting finish. Drink now through 2010. 75 cases made.—P.M.
- 90 Dupont-Tisserandot Charmes-Chambertin 2001 \$80** A seductive red—thick, rich and ripe, with plenty of lively, vibrant raspberries, black cherries and blackberries. Pronounced oak, but it stays in check, producing a balanced finish of smoke and fruit. Drink now through 2013.—P.M.
- 90 Mommessin Charmes-Chambertin 2001 \$90** Seductive. Very pretty, tasting like cassis concentrate, with mineral, vanilla extract, cream and blackberries. Medium-bodied, the fruit bursts with balance, leaving a juicy, succulent trail of flavors on
