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94 Dupont-Tisserandot Gevrey-Chambertin Lavaux St.-Jacques 2002 \$70 Beautiful ripe, pure flavors of cherry and spice, lush in texture and backed by firm tannins. It starts out beguiling, shutting down on the finish, which suggests waiting a few more years before approaching this red. Fine balance and harmony. Best from 2007 through 2017.—B.S.

93 Dupont-Tisserandot Gevrey-Chambertin Les Cazetiers 2002 \$70 A huge red, displaying gorgeous black cherry, blackberry and hints of vanilla married to a lush, velvety texture. Very modern in style, with well-integrated tannins and a long cherry- and spice-infused finish. Drink now through 2015.—B.S.

93 Dupont-Tisserandot Mazis-Chambertin 2002 \$110 Very pure, with black cherry, violet and cassis aromas and flavors melding with bright acidity and velvety texture backed by a firm grip. Concentrated and beautifully integrated, followed by a long finish. Best from 2006 through 2018.—B.S.

92 Dupont-Tisserandot Gevrey-Chambertin La Petite Chapelle 2002 \$70 A high-toned red, showing black cherry, spicy oak and licorice notes. Very modern in style, with suppleness and firm, well-integrated tannins. Not as much *terroir* here as some of its peers, but tasty. Fine length. Best from 2006 through 2012.—B.S.
