→ **91** **Domaine Chataigneraie-Laborier Pouilly-Fuissé La Roche 2004 \$35** Ripe and round, with flavors verging on apricot, with a peach core and butter and spice from the oak treatment. This is concentrated, well-structured and long on the finish. Drink now through 2010. 100 cases imported.—B.S.

→ **89** **Domaine Chataigneraie-Laborier Pouilly-Fuissé Bélemnites 2004 \$30** Lovely balance and harmony here. Peach, apple, lemon and mineral notes mingle with a bright structure. It has intensity and length, but needs time to come together. Best from 2007 through 2012. 250 cases imported.—B.S.

→ **88** **Domaine Chataigneraie-Laborier Pouilly-Fuissé 2004 \$20** If you like the taste of Chardonnay, this white is for you. A straightforward, unadorned style offering apple, lemon and mineral flavors with a crisp finish. Well-balanced and appealing. Drink now. 400 cases imported.—B.S.
