

Wine Spectator Praises Gilles Morat's 2009 Pouilly-Fuisse Collection, Giving All Three Cuvées 90 Points

90 Gilles Morat Pouilly-Fuissé 2009 \$25

A soft, plush white, with a hint of bitterness supporting the peach and pastry flavors. There's a mineral streak buried in there too, resonating on the finish. Drink now through 2016. 250 cases imported.—B.S.

90 Gilles Morat Pouilly-Fuissé Bélemnites 2009

\$35 A round, opulent version, filled with honey, peach and grapefruit flavors, this harmonious white holds together well, with a hint of burnt sugar on the aftertaste. Drink now through 2014. 100 cases imported.—B.S.

90 Gilles Morat Pouilly-Fuissé La Roche 2009

\$38 Broad and lush, featuring spicy peach, grapefruit and hazelnut flavors enhanced by oak spice notes. Shows intensity and harmony in an oversized way. Drink now through 2014. 70 cases imported.—B.S.
