90 **Domaine Chataigneraie-Laborier Pouilly-Fuissé Bélemnites 2006 \$32** Very creamy, with lanolin, vanilla, apricot and citrus notes. The vibrant structure provides lift and precision, as this builds to a fine finish. Best from 2009 through 2014. 75 cases imported.—B.S.

89 **Domaine Chataigneraie-Laborier Pouilly-Fuissé La Roche 2006 \$35** Taut and lemony, yet with a mineral element, giving this white a sense of place. Bright and linear, with a lingering, mouthwatering finish. Best from 2009 through 2013. 50 cases imported.—B.S.

88 **Domaine Chataigneraie-Laborier Pouilly-Fuissé 2006 \$25** Bracing, with a stony, almost briny quality, showing fresh lemon flavors and a touch of herb. Balanced on the sharp side, with a mouthwatering finish. Drink now through 2012. 250 cases imported.—B.S.
