

## Wine Spectator recognizes Pierre & Jean-Baptiste Lebreuil's Outstanding 2005s

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**91 Pierre & Jean-Baptiste Lebreuil Savigny-lès-Beaune Aux Peuillets 2005 \$50** Shows fine purity, grip and intensity. Black cherry, spice and mineral notes match the dense tannins and bright acidity, keeping this focused. There's enough sweet fruit to tame the tannins in the end, with a long aftertaste of cherry and mineral. Best from 2009 through 2020. 25 cases imported.—B.S.

**90 Pierre & Jean-Baptiste Lebreuil Savigny-lès-Beaune Les Grands Liards 2005 \$40** The vibrant structure brings the cherry and earth notes into relief. This is a linear red, with firm but balanced tannins. Best from 2009 through 2015. 75 cases imported.—B.S.
