Meursault Clos St.-Félix 2008

90 points | \$40 | 50 cases imported | White

A nutty, buttery white, offering up-front richness, a juicy profile and apple, lemon and earth notes lurking in the background. This has fine concentration and length. Drink now through 2018.—B.S

Meursault Les Grands Charrons 2008

91 points | \$48 | NA cases made | White

Lime blossom, acacia, hazelnut and spice aromas and flavors highlight this elegant, intense white, which is linear in profile, with tension and energy through the mineral finish. Best from 2011 through 2019.—B.S.

Meursault Charmes 2008

92 points | \$70 | NA cases made | White

A lean, sleek style, packed tight with hazelnut, peach, lime blossom and mineral notes. Very elegant, with fine tension, cohesion and a lingering aftertaste. Best from 2012 through 2024.—B.S.

Meursault Perrières 2008

92 points | \$90 | NA cases made | White

Still needs a little time to come together, yet this intense white is already showing white peach, spring blossoms, baking spices and mineral notes, with a hint of grapefruit peel. Stays fresh and firm on the finish. Best from 2012 through 2023.—B.S.
