The vineyard of Verdigny, shown below, as viewed from the top of the slope. The soil here is predominantly limestone which warms quickly and, together with the gentle slope, enhances the ripening of the grapes



Grass is planted between the rows to prevent erosion. Roses are very sensitive to disease and indicate the onset of any problems. Prieur is thus able to use minimal treatments on his vines.



Prieur's Pinot Noir vineyard, at the base of the Mont Damnes site. The soil is deeper and well suited to Pinot. The vines are 40 years old. The view is facing east, with the town of Sancerre in the background.
