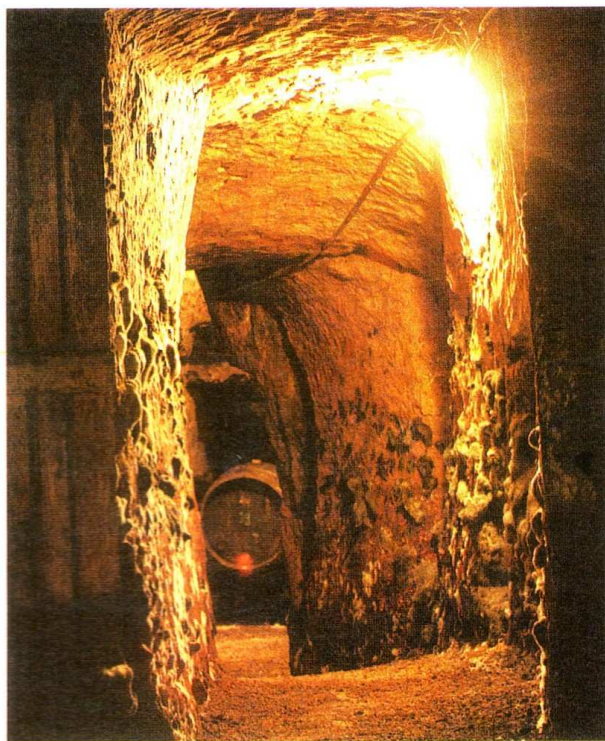
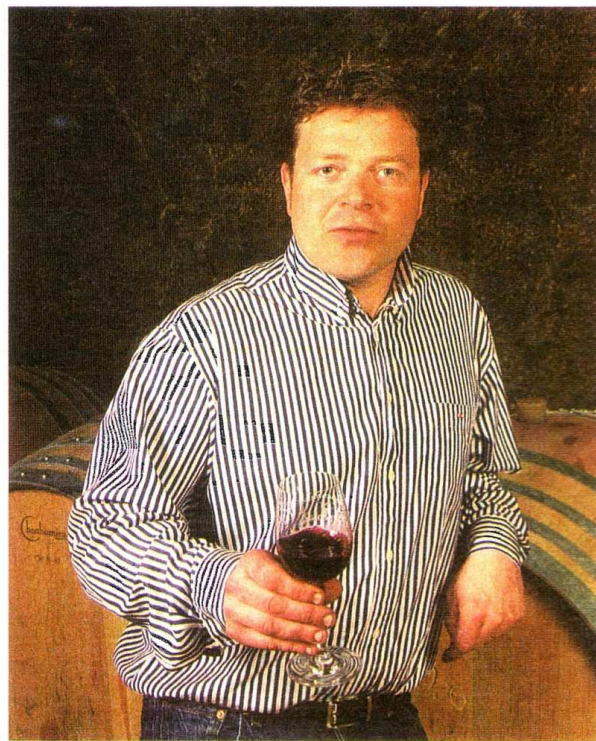


Wine Spectator spotlights Loire Reds

As head of the estate, **Rodolphe Raffault** has expanded its holdings and improved quality.

“**Rodolphe Raffault**, who took over his family domaine, **Jean-Maurice Raffault**, from his father in 1997, produces his **Clos des Capucins** bottling from a 3.5-acre parcel of terraced vines on clay and flint soils. Since the wine’s debut in 2001, it has steadily become one of the appellation’s top bottlings.”
