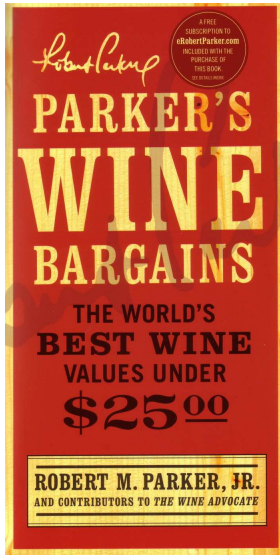

RAINER WESS (*Wachau and Kremstal*)

Grüner Veltliner Terrassen 🍷 \$\$\$ Wess's Grüner Veltliner Terrassen typically features green beans, snap peas, coffee, and pit fruits; considerable fullness and a glossy-textured palate; yet plenty of lift and refreshment.

Grüner Veltliner Wachauer 🍷 \$\$\$ Sporting flowers, snap peas, and citrus, this offers a soft, luscious, yet still typically nippy example of Austria's national signature grape.

Riesling Terrassen 🍷 \$\$\$ Peach, lemon, and almond are key notes in this sleek, refined, richly textured and long-finishing Riesling value, which originates in some very fine, steep sites.

Riesling Wachauer 🍷 \$\$\$ No more expensive than its Grüner Veltliner counterpart, this finishes with lip-smacking generosity as well as smoky, saline minerality and faintly bitter fruit-pit complications that one has no right to expect for the price.
